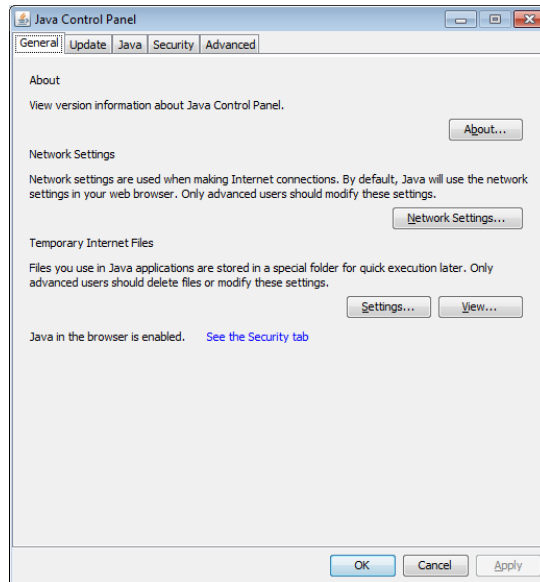


JAVA 7 u51 Fix

There are too many operating systems to list 'how to' instructions to get to this point.

Stage 1

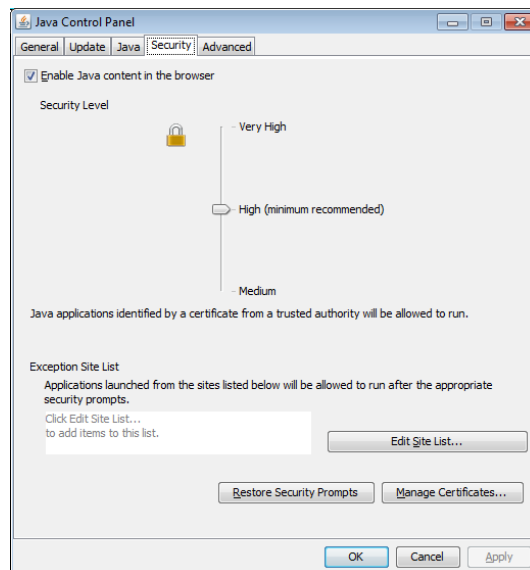
Open the Java console window. It should look like the picture below.



Once you have it opened the Java console you need to select the 'Security' tab, as show in the next graphic. If you have the latest version of Java installed you will see a button labelled 'Edit Site List'.

If this button is not visible then you do not have the latest version of Java installed.

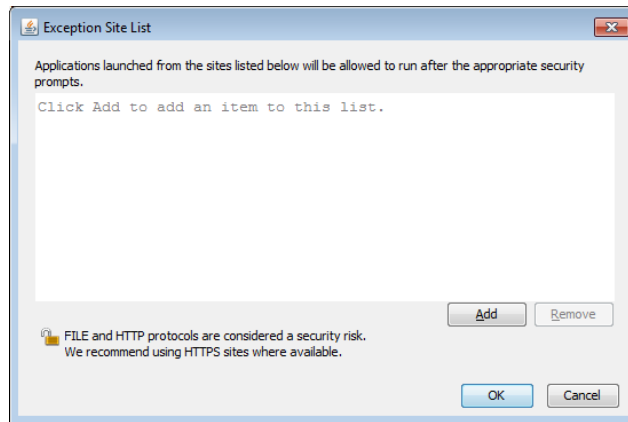
Below is how the console should look. If your screen looks like the once below then continue. If not then these instructions will not assist.



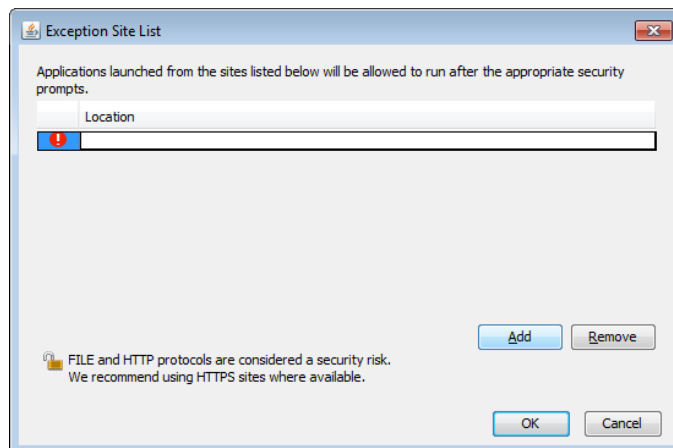

You now need to click the 'Edit Site List' button.

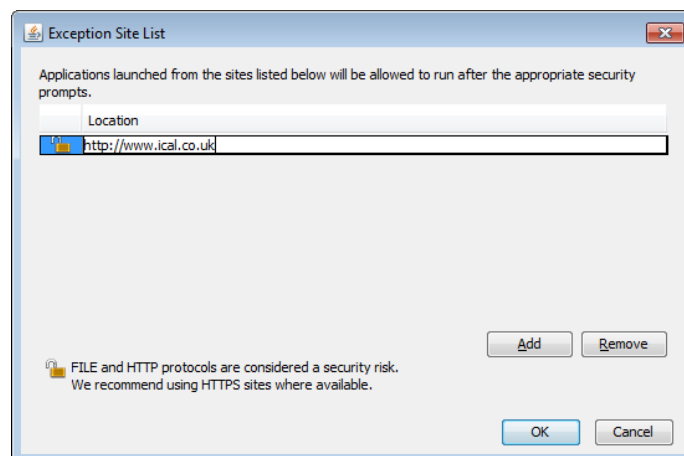
When you do this a new window will appear like the one shown below.



You need to click the 'Add' button and the next screen will appear.



In the location white box you need to type <http://www.ical.co.uk>

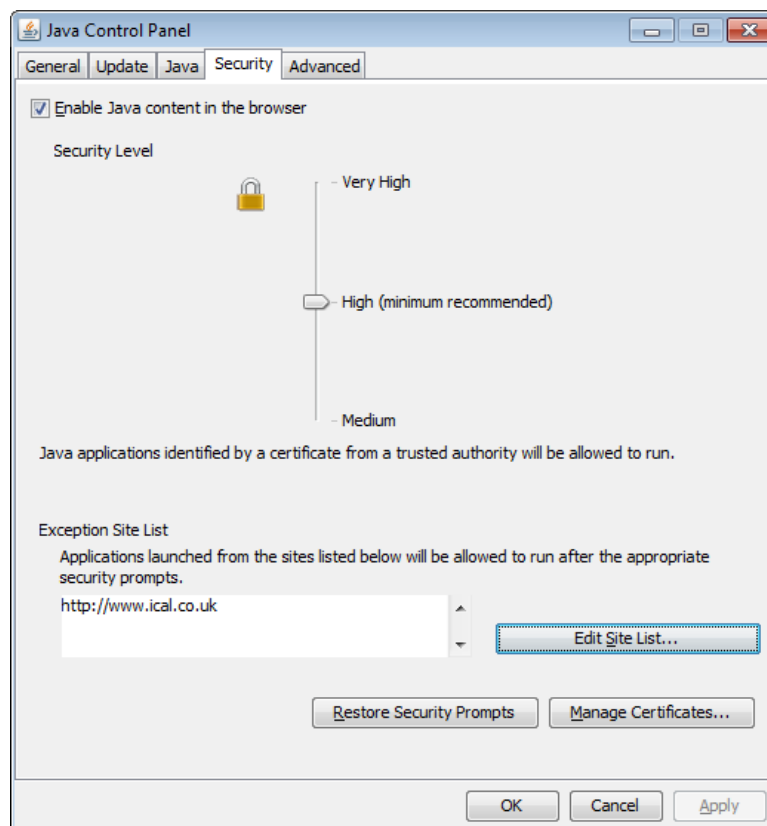


When you have typed it click the 'OK' button and the following warning screen will appear.

You need to click the 'Continue' button and the below screen should appear showing the exception site list with `http://www.ical.co.uk`.



All you need to do now is click 'OK' and the console will close down.

The work around process is now complete and the ICAL java applet should run normally.
